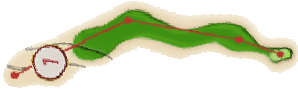


## RECOMMENDATIONS FOR BEST PRO GAME STRATEGY



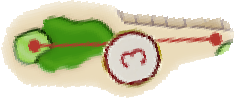
Hole 1 - par 5

Your best option is to line your drive up targeting the left side of the fairway. For your second shot keep the ball on the right.



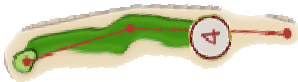
Hole 2 - par 4

For hole 2, it is best to play a long shot along the left side of the fairway than it is to play the shorter distance to the right side. The shot to the green is definitely on the right side.



Hole 3 - par 3

This green slopes right to left so your target is the high side of the green (the right side). If you miss this shot and the ball rolls off the green it is preferable that your error to the left to finish with an uphill putt.



Hole 4 - par 4

Your tee shot should target the right side of the fairway. From this position you are on target to reach the green especially when the flag is placed on the right side of the green. Beware as this green is small!



Hole 5 - Par 3

This green is protected by huge bunkers to the front right of the green forcing you to play to the central or left side.



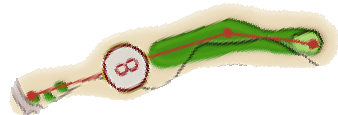
Hole 6 - Par 5

It is one of the most difficult drives because of the location of the landing zone, so it is recommended to shot for the left side of the fairway. This green is difficult because it is terraced therefore you must play the ball low on the approach shots targeting in the area of the flag.



Hole 7 - par 4

If you are not a long distance driver play your drive to land short of the hazard. From here you can play a short 80 yard shot into the green. Do not risk!



Hole 8 - par 4

This fairway is one of the easiest to play. To avoid the bunker near the landing zone, your target off the tee is the left side of the fairway.



Hole 9 - par 3

You'll need to put the ball on the green as close as possible to the flag position as the slopes are very long in all directions. Avoid four putting!



Hole 10 - par 4

Play this one short to avoid problems with your tee shot. I recommend using an iron just to put the ball in play, the hole is short and an iron shot will help you to avoid the hazards on both sides.



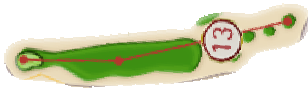
Hole 11 - par 4

Here you will want to play your tee shot to the right side of fairway to take the tree in the center out of play, but beware of the hazard.



Hole 12 - par 3

It is best to play this green short. If you play it long you will have to contend with the sand bunker, the hazard and o.b. behind the green.



Hole 13 - par 4

I recommend that you always play your second shot to the left side of green as it will run on very strong slope to the right. Watch out!



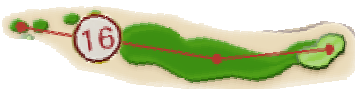
Hole 14 - par 5

For your second shot you will want to aim left and lay up before the bank of bunkers as the slope will run your ball to the right. Beware of the o.b.!



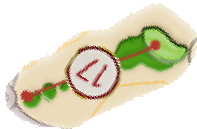
Hole 15 - par 4

Put your driver away as you can easily reach the area of bunkers in front on the fairway.



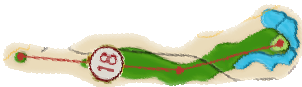
Hole 16 - par 4

Another green that you have to play very carefully. Place your shot as close to the flag to avoid a three putt.



Hole 17 - par 3

Play to the left side of the green as you will still have a chance to par the hole from a sand bunker. A much better option than to fly your ball into the water hazard on the right.



Hole 18 - par 4

A little secret, Nick Faldo designed this hole with the Parroquia Parish as your target off the tee. You need to play this hole carefully as the fairway shots to the green are challenging. If you are not able to make the green on your second shot it is best to layup short of the green taking the water and sand traps out of play finishing with a par or a bogie.
